



We know good manners(举止) are important. People in different countries usually have different ways of doing things. Something that is rude in one country may be quite polite in another.

For example, in Britain you mustn't lift your bowl to your mouth when you are having liquid (液体的) food. That is considered bad manners

in Britain. But in Japan you needn't worry about making a noise when you drink something. It shows that you are enjoying it.

In Britain we try not to put our hands on the table at all during a meal. In Mexico, however, guests are expected to keep their hands on the table throughout a meal. In Arabic countries we

must be careful with our hands. You see, in Arabic countries you mustn't eat with your left hand. This is considered to be very impolite.

So, what should you do if you visit a foreign country? Well, you needn't worry. You can ask the native people (当地人) there to help you and you can just watch carefully and try to do what they do.

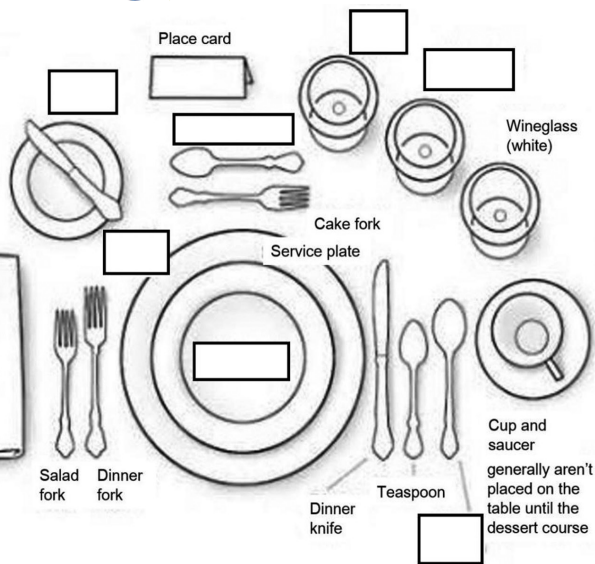

#### Laying the Table

##### Cutlery (餐具)

Put forks on the left, and knives and soup spoons on the right. The different knives and forks are for the different courses. The small knife and fork are for the first course; the big ones are for the main course, and the small knife on the small plate is for butter or cheese. As a general rule, when you eat you start on the

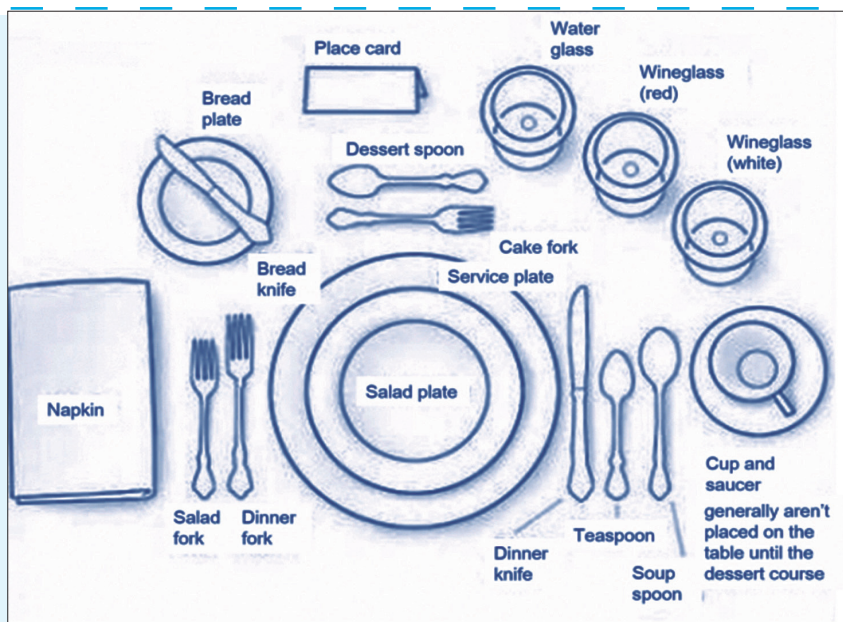
outside and move into the plate. The spoon and small fork at the top are for dessert.

##### Plates

The small plate is for bread and is always on the left. In the middle, there are usually some plates, and the smallest one is for salad.

##### Glasses

There are usually at least two glasses. They are on the right, above the knives. They are water glass and wineglass.
